

The following schedule is based on the work provided to kindergarten students on a regular day at school. Links to online stories, games and songs have been included but do not necessarily need to be completed. We understand that the completion of this amount of work may not always be achievable and stress that this is simply a guide of what can be done. It is advised however, to help our kindergarten students continue with their progress, that a focus on the English and mathematics concepts would be most beneficial.

Morning	School Holidays	<p>English</p> <p>Practise your sight words from last term by saying each word three times.</p> <p>Complete <i>'Rhyming Pairs'</i> worksheet. Circle and colour in the words that rhyme on each line.</p> <p>Ask parent/carer to introduce the sight words for the week by looking and saying each one three times. Shuffle and repeat.</p> <p>Complete worksheet <i>'What's in the Middle 1'</i>. Say each word and circle the middle sound. Pick 3 of the words and try writing them.</p> <p>Make and read with your parent/caretaker your little book about the <i>'Three Little Pigs'</i>. Answer the questions at the back of your little book.</p> <p>Complete the <i>Three Little Pigs</i> puppets. Colour, cut out and make the puppets. Retell the story using your puppets.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Practise this week's sight words by saying each word three times.</p> <p>Find a book and see if you can find any of these words.</p> <p>Complete <i>'when' and 'some'</i> worksheet. Colour in all the words that are the same and count how many you find.</p> <p>Complete worksheet <i>'Missing Middle Sounds'</i>. Say each word and write the missing middle sound.</p> <p>Reread your Three Little Pigs little book with a parent/carer.</p> <p>Complete worksheet - <i>Three Little Pigs</i> sequencing.</p> <p>Write 2-3 sentences about what happened in the story.</p> <p>Read a text from your PM readers online.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Practise this week's sight words by saying each word three times.</p> <p>Practise writing this week's words on a whiteboard, blackboard or a piece of paper. Can you write them without looking?</p> <p>Complete worksheet <i>'all' and 'one'</i>. Find all the <i>'all'</i> words and trace, write and find all the <i>'one'</i> words.</p> <p>Complete worksheet <i>What's in the Middle 2</i>. Say each word and circle the middle sound. Pick 1 of the words and try writing a sentence with it.</p> <p>Watch the video about Pigs. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=bui3jv8iQw8</p> <p>Complete worksheet <i>Label the parts of a pig</i> - ear snout tail leg hoof eye</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Practise this week's sight words by saying each word three times.</p> <p>Play a game such as stepping stones or memory match using this week's sight words.</p> <p>Complete worksheet <i>'Colour by Sight Words'</i>.</p> <p>Complete worksheet <i>'Middle Sounds'</i>. Say each word and write the missing middle sound.</p> <p>Complete sentence sequencing cut and paste worksheet <i>'The little pig likes to play in the mud'</i>.</p> <p>Use your imagination and draw a picture of a Super Pig. Write 2-3 sentences about your Super Pig. What powers does it have? How does it save the day?</p> <p>For fun listen to the Super Pig Song.</p>

Afternoon		<p>Creative arts</p> <p>Can you draw a picture of a pig like this one below? Start with a circle for his head, add his nose, eyes and then ears.</p> <p>Now draw his body. Add his legs then curly tail.</p>  <p>What colour will you paint or colour your pig. Is your pig playing in the mud too?</p>	<p>Geography</p> <p>Think about, where do you live? What makes your home so special?</p> <p>Discuss your favourite place in your home with a parent/carer and tell them why this is special.</p> <p>Draw a picture of yourself in your favourite place. Remember to use lots of beautiful colours and make your place interesting.</p>	<p>Creative arts</p> <p>Sing 'Old McDonald had a farm'. Complete the actions for each animal. Count how many animals you can sing about.</p> <p>Make some little puppets to go with the song. You could draw some animals on paper and cut them out and stick them on pencils.</p> <p>You could even try to make a puppet using an old sock.</p>	<p>PDHPE</p> <p>Practise throwing and catching a ball with a family member.</p> <p>Draw a hopscotch and practise hopping and jumping through the squares.</p> <p>See how long you can balance on one leg. Change legs</p> <p>Challenge your parent/carer to balance on one leg too.</p>
