The following schedule is based on the work provided to kindergarten students on a regular day at school. Links to online material have been included but do not necessarily need to be completed. Highlighted activities have been included as suggestions for students who do not have access to a printer. We understand that the completion of this amount of work may not always be achievable and stress that this is simply a guide of what **can** be done.

	Revise last week's sight words by saying each word three times. Ask your parent/carer to introduce the sight words for the week by looking and saying each one three times. Shuffle and repeat. Complete the "soon" sight word worksheet (Sight Word Detectives worksheet). Read, trace, fill in the boxes, write, decorate, circle, colour the letters, find, and fill in the missing letters for the word "soon". OR practise writing the word "soon" on a piece of paper or whiteboard. Then practise writing the sentence "Soon it will be playtime." Cut out 4 small pieces of paper, write each letter in "soon" on each piece. Shuffle the letters and then put them in the correct order to spell "soon". Repeat and see if you can do it faster.	Practise your sight words from this term by saying each word three times. Shuffle and repeat. Complete the "talk" sight word worksheet (Super Start Sight Words). Read, trace, colour, write, highlight, fill in the missing letters and write it in a sentence. OR practise writing the word "talk" on a piece of paper or whiteboard. Then practise writing the sentence "I can talk to my dog". Now clap the word "talk", how many syllables/parts does it have? Complete worksheet Ice Cream Word Families. Cut out the ice cream scoop words. Then match the scoops by gluing them on top of the piece of pie with the same word family. The words all have the "ab, eb, ob, ub" word family in them. OR Ask your parent/carer to say some "ab, eb, ib, ob or ub" words to you	Practise this week's sight words by saying each word three times. Find a book and see if you can find any of these words. Complete the "could" sight word worksheet (Bee, Bee Bumblebee worksheet). Read, write, clap, colour, trace, spell, find, tell and complete the sentence for the word "could". OR practise writing the word "could" on a piece of paper or whiteboard. Then practise writing the sentence "I could hear the birds singing yesterday." Now play a game of Stepping Stones with your sight words from this week and last week. Complete worksheet Word Family Read, Write & Match! - ib. Read, write and colour the matching picture for each 'ib' word. Then read the sentence and fill in the missing 'ib' word. Lastly, find the list of 'ib' words in the word search.	Practise this week's sight words by saying each word three times. Practise writing this week's words on a whiteboard, blackboard or a piece of paper. Can you write them without looking? Complete the "find" sight word worksheet. Trace, write, colour, find and draw a picture to match the sentence that uses the word "find". OR practise writing the word "find" on a piece of paper or whiteboard. Now write "find" 10 times on a whiteboard or on a piece of paper as fast as you can! Complete worksheet Word Family Fun - ob. Read, write and colour the matching picture for each 'ob' word. Then find the list of 'ob' words in the word search. Tick them off as you find them. OR Write as many "ob" words that you can think of. Write a sentence using one	Practise this week's sight words by saying each word three times. Play Find the Treasure with your sight word cards. Choose 10 sight word cards, lay them face down and ask your parent/carer to hide a button under one of the words. Then turn each card over, say the sight word, until you find the treasure. Complete the Colour by Sight Words worksheet. Complete worksheet Is it ab, eb, ib, ob or ub? Cut out the word family words at the bottom of the page, stretch and say each word and then glue it under the matching picture. Ask your parent/carer to get you to say the number that comes <u>before</u> 3, 8, 10, 17, 19.

Order your numeral cards from 1-20. Now order them from 20-1.

Choose one of your numeral cards and make that number out of pop-sticks, matchsticks, buttons or blocks. Count and check that the number of objects matches the number you chose. Repeat for further numbers.

Ask your parent/carer to get you to say the number that comes <u>after</u> 1, 7, 9, 16, 19.

Play a game of Guess My Number with your parent/carer. They choose a number between 1-20 and you ask questions like, is your number higher than 10, is it lower than 15, etc. Repeat for other numbers.

Use your Making Teen Numbers with Ten Frames template (found in the resources folder in the Classwork tab in Google Classroom) to make some teen numbers. You could use blocks, counters, dried pasta or buttons to make your teen numbers.

Complete worksheet – Drawing Ten Frames

Now order the towers from smallest to largest.

Go outside and do 15 starjumps. Don't forget to count as you jump! Go on a hunt to find a variety of objects around your home. Sort them into piles of objects that look like a box, a ball, a cone or a can. Count how many items are in each group.

Now sort them into groups based on items that can roll, stack or slide. Count how many items are in each group.

For fun - You might like to try sorting them in other ways e.g. by colour, size or function (how it is used).

Go outside and do 10 lunges. Remember to count!
