

Attendance

100% Attendance Semester 1 reward to Bowling last week. Students and I had a great time. Date already planned (Week 10- Wednesday 13th December) for S2 100% attendance students- just looking at the event.

Weekly attendance – great start by 4Kangaroos last week whose attendance rate was 96.15%-exceeding the school target. Attendance rates for the week are varied though from 58.62% to 96.15%. Aware that there are viruses in the community.

Last week from our 503 students we had 323 students with full 100% attendance and 376 who attended school all week so 43 students over the week who had partials- late or early. We follow

our attendance procedures to improve student attendance- this includes calling parents on the 2nd day of an absence unless we have already heard from one of the parents.
