#### <u>Yandyinyang</u>

As you all know we are welcoming Special Education classes to JEPS. Mr Jessey Cohen, in consultation with Aboriginal author Jasmine Seymour, have collaborated on the name YANDYINYANG - (Phonetically pronounced Yarn-Jin-Young, say it with a little speed). The meaning of this is WE ALL WALK. And for us at JEPS, we will all walk in togetherness as a community, alongside our newest students to provide inclusiveness and equity in learning and life outcomes. We will not refer to our classes as 'special ed' classes or 'the unit' – Yandyinyang is our reference. Thank you all for your ongoing support of Yandyinyang and the students who will soon join us in this space.

# Yandyinyang staff

We have been able to staff our first class that will begin approximately week 5 or 6 of this term. The classroom teacher permanently appointed is Ms Dallas Hepi, who has worked at JEPS for the past 2 years and who is in the process of beginning her Masters in Inclusive Education. The SLSO is Ms Emma Jackson – who has been permanently appointed to the school in Yandyinyang. Congratulations to both Ms Hepi and Ms Jackson.

In week 4 I will be working with staffing to recruit another teacher, an Assistant Principal and 2 SLSO's to staff the further 2 classes that will start in 2025.

### Swimming Carnival 2025

### Matai Voices

We have a creative and performing arts program to work with select students. The program is run by Matai Arts & Innovation and titled: Voices – Bringing Stories to Life through Performance. The program offers a holistic approach centered on student voice, creativity and collaboration where students explore themes, learn to express themselves authentically and develop essential communication skills. They are working with students in Stage 3.
